The NYSF Year 12 Program is for students who are:

- in Year 11 at the time of application
- Australian students, or studying at an Australian school
- interested in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM)

NEED FINANCIAL SUPPORT?


As part of the application process, any students experiencing financial hardship or another disadvantage that negatively impacts their ability to attend the program may apply for an NYSF Access and Equity Scholarship.

We also encourage students to seek financial support from NYSF's founding partner, Rotary. Many Rotary Clubs are familiar with the NYSF and able to offer some level of funding or assist students to fundraise to attend. Further details on how to access funding assistance will be sent to all applicants at key stages of the application and selection process.



STEPS TO APPLY

1. Start an online application at nysf@nysf.edu.au
2. Complete the application, including:
 - a. Answering all questions, and
 - b. Uploading your most recent school report
3. Pay the \$65 application fee and submit your application by mid-July.
4. Your application will be reviewed by a Selection Panel.
5. Offers will be sent in August.
6. Program fees are due in October.
