Over the three days, attendees will experience the very best of STEM in Australia and hear from some of Australia's top STEM leaders via keynote presentations from the Chief Scientist of Australia, Dr Cathy Foley AO and Vice-Chancellor of the Australian National University, Professor Genevieve Bell AO, plus interactive workshops, a STEM Study and Careers Expo, panel discussions, and networking opportunities, culminating in a Gala Dinner at The Great Hall, Australian Parliament House featuring guest speaker Minister for Industry & Science, the Hon Ed Husic MP, to celebrate the 40th Anniversary of the National Youth Science Forum.

## STEM STUDY AND CAREERS EXHIBITION




A two-hour STEM Study and Careers Expo will be held on the third day of the STEM Summit.
